WHAT is Student mobility?

„International Credit Mobility“ = project supporting mobilities between programme and partner countries

Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport using mobility and cooperation opportunities in higher education.

WHY APPLY?

Erasmus+ mobility has positive effects on educational, social, personal and professional development, in that it enhances knowledge, skills and attitudes, improves employability, helps confidence-building and independence, stimulates curiosity and innovation and fosters the understanding of other people and nations.

WHERE TO GO?

The Partnership under this project was set up between the *Université Dan Dicko Dankoulodo de Maradi (UDDM)*, and the *Czech University of Life Sciences Prague, Faculty of Tropical AgriSciences (FTA, CZU)*

SUPPORTED MOBILITIES:

- 1 students (MSc/PhD) for 5 months for studies for students of UDDDM
- female students are encouraged
- interest in Wildlife management preferable

Financial support:
800 EUR / month
+ 820 EUR travel scholarship

Notes:

- This call is for mobilities carried out in the first semester of the academic year 2024/2025 (from September 2024)
- All students are eligible, they must be students of the UDDDM during whole period of the mobility
- Students need to prove "Register from Criminal Records" to the Czech Embassy while applying for visa

2. CV (in Europass format)
3. Transcript of study records
4. Learning Agreement
or Training Agreement
5. English Language certificates (optional)
6. Copy of your passport
